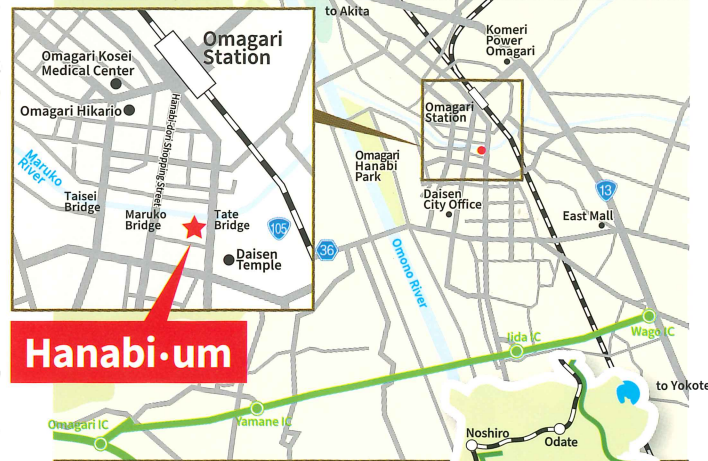

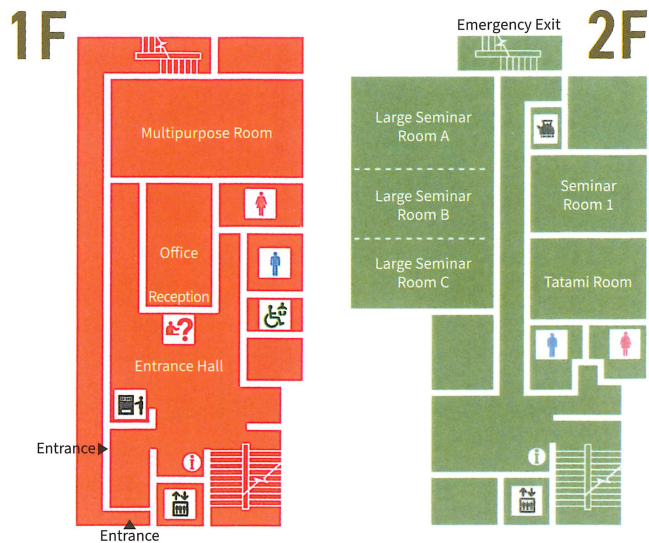

Names of past prize recipients at Omagari Hanabi are displayed in the Entrance Hall.



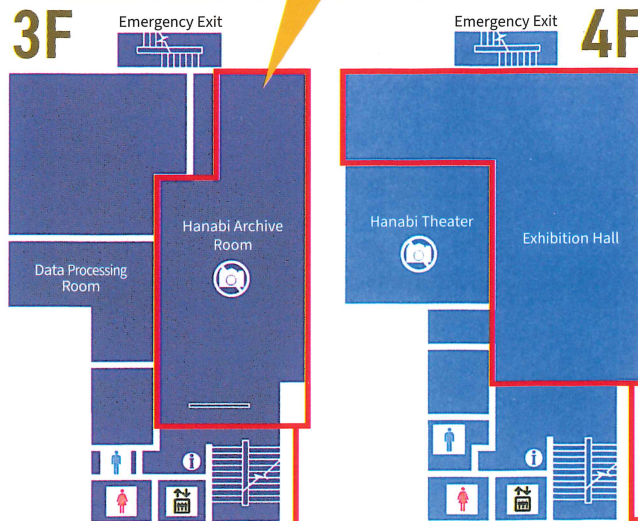
2 F : Seminar Room

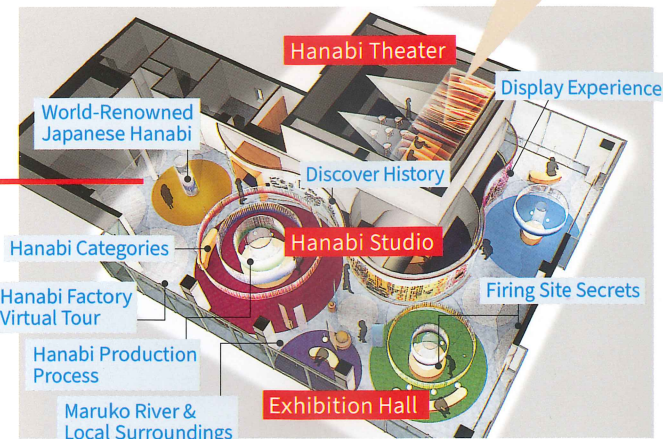
Hanabi Archive Room
